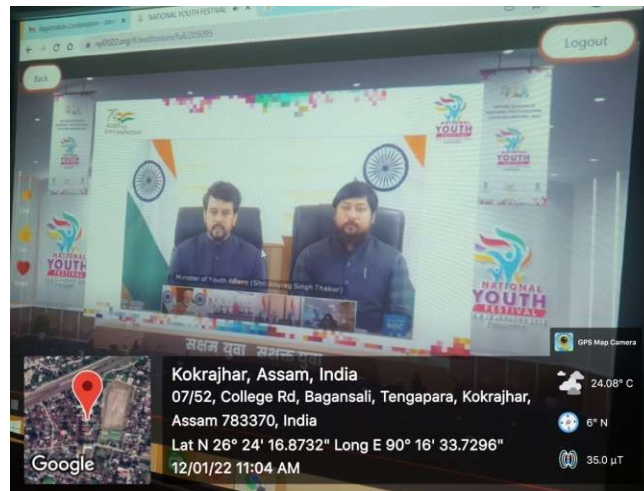
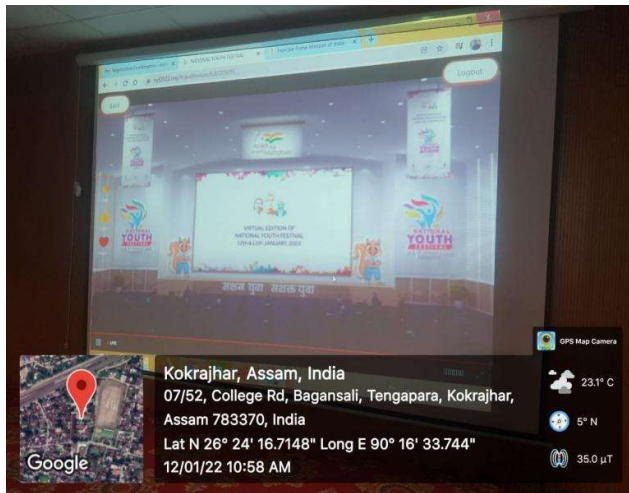

Objective : The objective of NSS Day celebration was to make volunteers about NSS and its history along with orientation programme for newly recruited NSS volunteers.

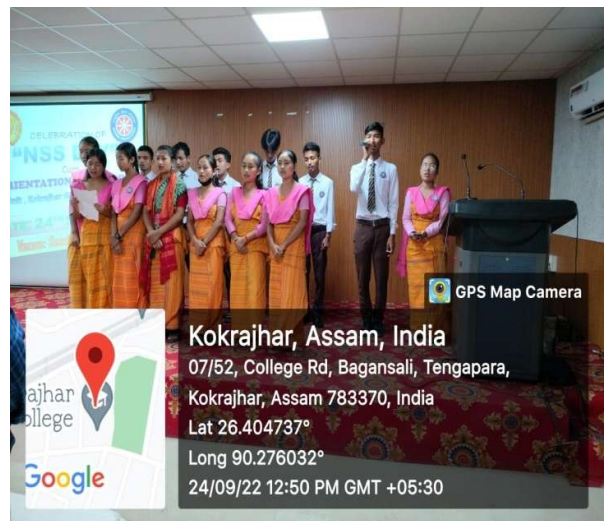

After a short discussion with the village headman, the volunteers surveyed few houses and took information about their culture, tradition, foods, methods of cultivation, women Empowerment, Social and Harmony, Health condition, Education and Economic status.

After a prolonged and tiredbared survey we came to conclude that the youths of Kakrikhola village was not interested in higher education, most the people were illiterate. They were not getting scope from the government, the roads were not constructed properly and the transport system was not well developed.

Public were suffering due to non-construction of bridge. The main reason for their lack of transport system was due to non-construction of roads and bridges. But the village had their own advantage that it was considered as the cleanest village of Kokrajhar. After the survey all the Volunteers gathered together and discussed how could we solve their problems.

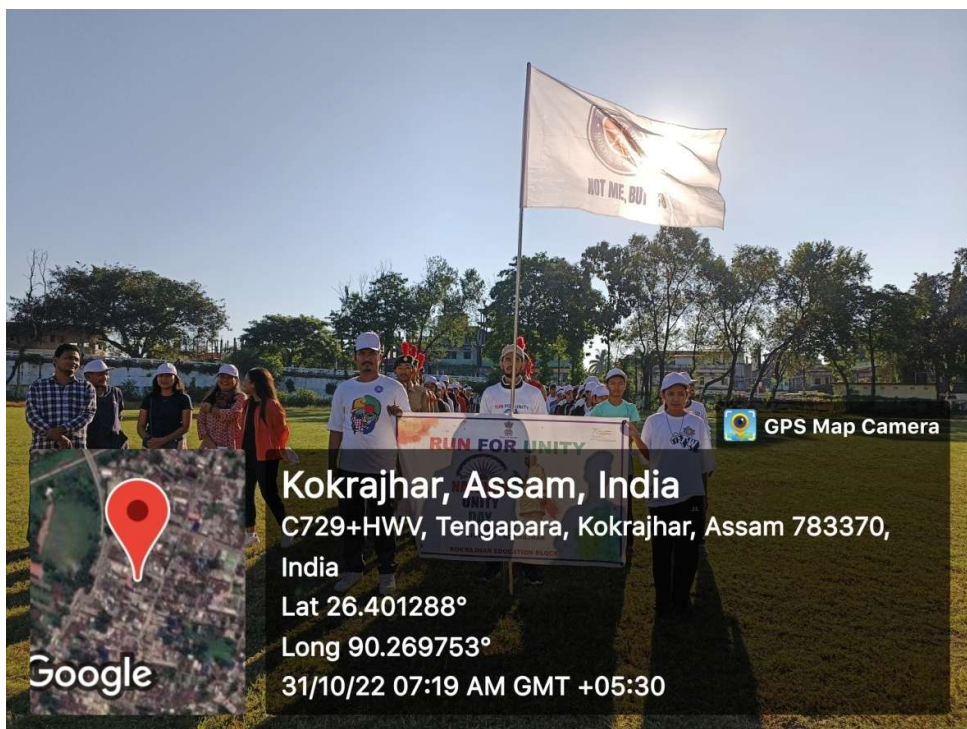

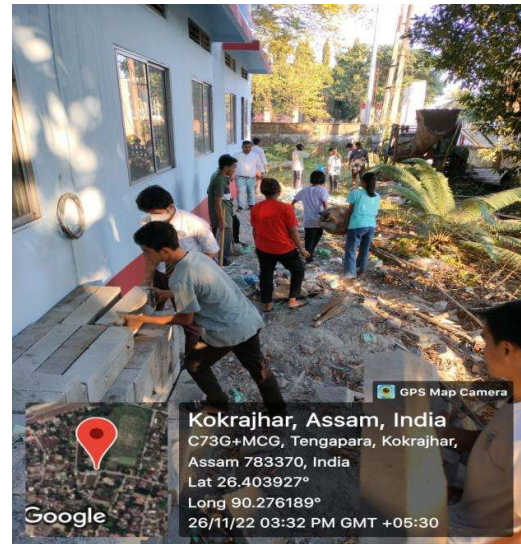
