### PRESS STATEMENT

#### **Signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Kokrajhar University and National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NEILIT), Guwahati, Assam.**

Kokrajhar University, Kokrajhar, entered into a significant Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT), Guwahati, on **21st November 2025**. NIELIT, being a premier Government of India institution under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), is renowned for its expertise in ICT training, digital skilling, and capacity building.

This MoU signifies a mutual commitment to enhance ICT-based education, promote digital empowerment, and strengthen skill development initiatives in the region. Through this partnership, Kokrajhar University aims to expand opportunities for its students by providing access to certified technology training programs that align with national skill development goals.

The representatives from Kokrajhar University were Prof. Ganesh Ch. Wary, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Kokrajhar University; Dr. Dimacha D. Mwchahary, Registrar, Kokrajhar University; Dr. Shickna John Wary, Academic Registrar (i/c), Kokrajhar, Dr. Bimal Kanti Basumatary, Dean of Students' Welfare (i/c), Kokrajhar University. The representatives from NEILIT, Guwahati were Santanu Borgohain, Scientist-E; Soumya Deb Purkayasta, Senior Technical Officer along with representatives from NEILIT, Kokrajhar, Dr. Bipul Roy, Scientist-D and Kamal Kumar Baglari, Senior Technical Officer.

The MoU aims to foster academic and skill development collaboration through the establishment of a NIELIT Study Centre at Kokrajhar University. The key objectives include Conducting ICT-based skilling programmes under the National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF), Promoting digital empowerment among students, Enhancing career-oriented skill development for youth in the region, Strengthening institutional cooperation in emerging areas of information technology and digital services. As part of this initiative, a total of 304 students have registered for the Certified Office Automation and IT Assistance Course for the academic session 2025-2026.

Following the formal signing ceremony, the delegation from NIELIT visited the Computer Centre of Kokrajhar University. The purpose of the visit was to review and assess the ongoing computer training programmes and understand the infrastructural readiness for the new ICT skill-based courses to be launched under the Study Centre. The MoU marks a significant milestone in strengthening digital learning and skill enhancement opportunities for students of Kokrajhar University and the surrounding region. The collaboration with NIELIT, a premier institution in ICT training, is expected to greatly contribute to increasing employability, fostering digital literacy, and empowering youths with industry-relevant technical skills.
