Report on District Level Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament 2026

Event Name : Kokrajhar District Level Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament 2026.

Objective : The Vikshit Bharat Youth Parliament–2026 was organised with the objective of promoting democratic values and creating awareness among youth about the importance of democracy and the lessons of the Emergency in India. The programme aimed to provide a platform for students to express their views, enhance their leadership, communication, and critical thinking skills, and encourage their active participation in democratic processes and nation-building in line with the vision of Vikshit Bharat.

Detailed Report:
