In compliance with the directives issued by the Government of Assam vide Letter No. eFile No. 789739/98-A, dated 16th June, 2026, the Anti-Drugs Cell of Kokrajhar University organized "Nasha Mukh Bharat Saptah" from 17th to 26th June, 2026 under the national campaign "Nasha Mukh Bharat Abhiyaan – Viksit Bharat Ki Pehchaan."

The observance was undertaken in alignment with the Government of India's vision of creating a **drug-free, healthy, and empowered society** through sustained awareness, preventive education, and community participation. The campaign sought to sensitize students, faculty members, officers, staff, and the wider community about the adverse physical, psychological, social, and economic consequences of substance abuse while encouraging them to adopt healthy lifestyles and become ambassadors of a drug-free nation.

Activities Conducted:

During the observance of Nasha Mukh Bharat Saptah, the University organized a series of awareness and community mobilisation activities, both on-campus and through digital platforms. The programmes were designed to maximize outreach and encourage active participation from all stakeholders. The major activities included:

- **Mass Pledge Drive:** Students, faculty members, officers, and staff took the Anti-Drug Pledge, reaffirming their commitment to abstain from drug abuse and to contribute towards creating a drug-free society.
- **Awareness Campaigns:** Awareness programmes were organized across the University campus to educate participants about the health hazards, legal implications, and socio-economic consequences of substance abuse. Informative interactions emphasized prevention, early intervention, and responsible citizenship.
- **Signature Campaign:** A campus-wide signature campaign was conducted to encourage members of the University community to publicly express their commitment to the ideals of the Nasha Mukh Bharat Abhiyaan and to promote a culture of collective responsibility.
- **Social Media Outreach:** Awareness messages, digital posters, informative graphics, campaign photographs, and anti-drug messages were disseminated through the University's official social media platforms to extend the campaign's reach beyond the campus and engage the wider community.
- **Community Mobilisation:** Students and members of the University actively participated in spreading awareness among peers and the local community, reinforcing the message that combating drug abuse requires collective action and sustained public participation.

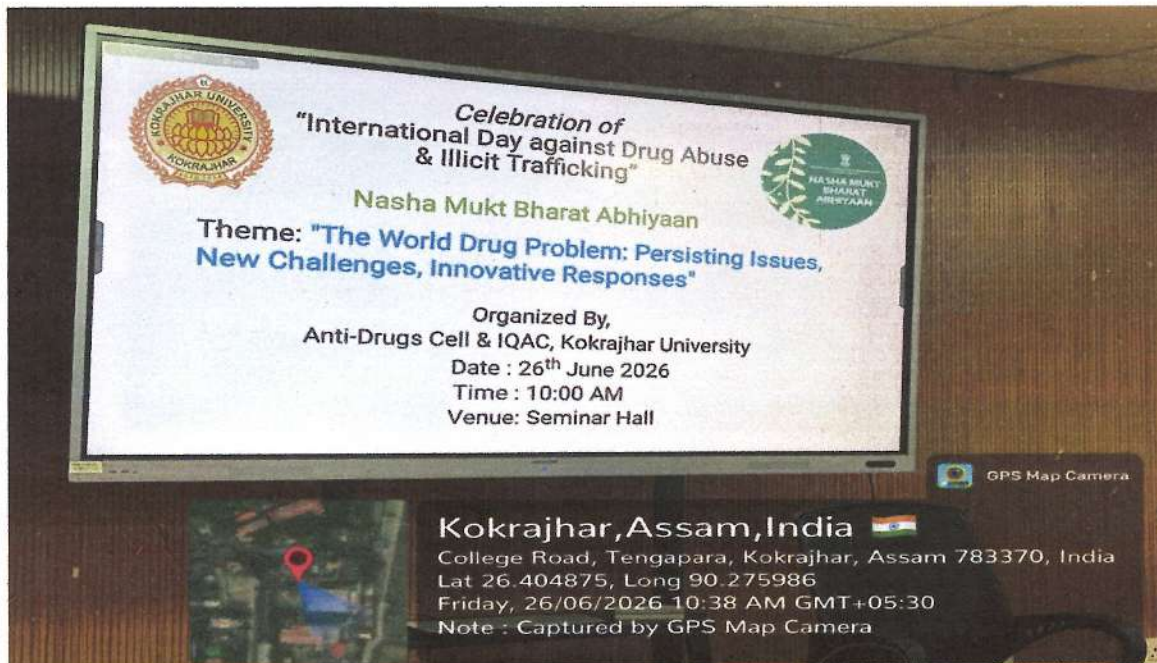



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Program 3: **Dated: 26th June 2026**

Dr. Sikhna John Wary, Academic Registrar, were present on the occasion and addressed the students.

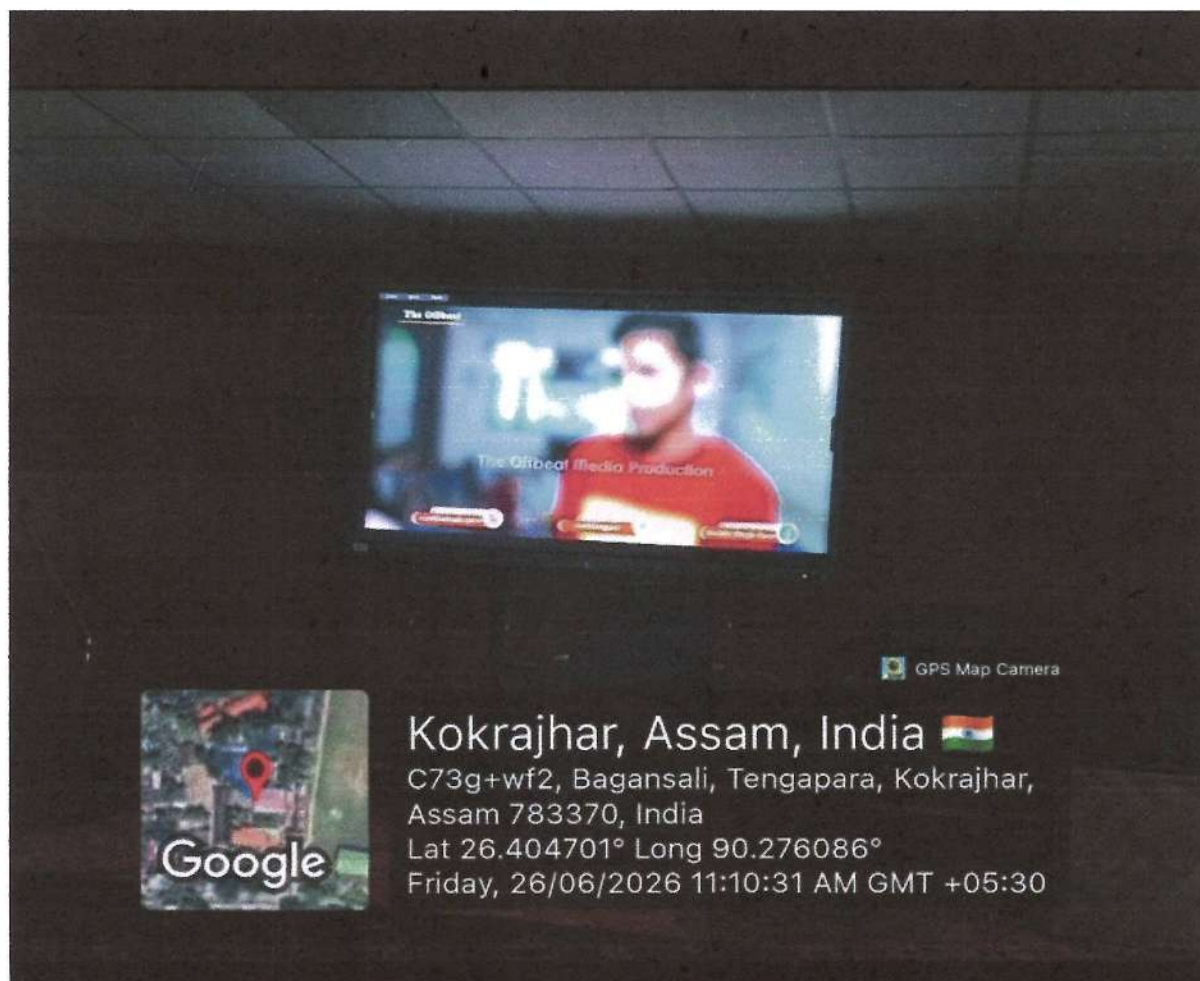



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Program 6: **Dated: 26th June 2026**

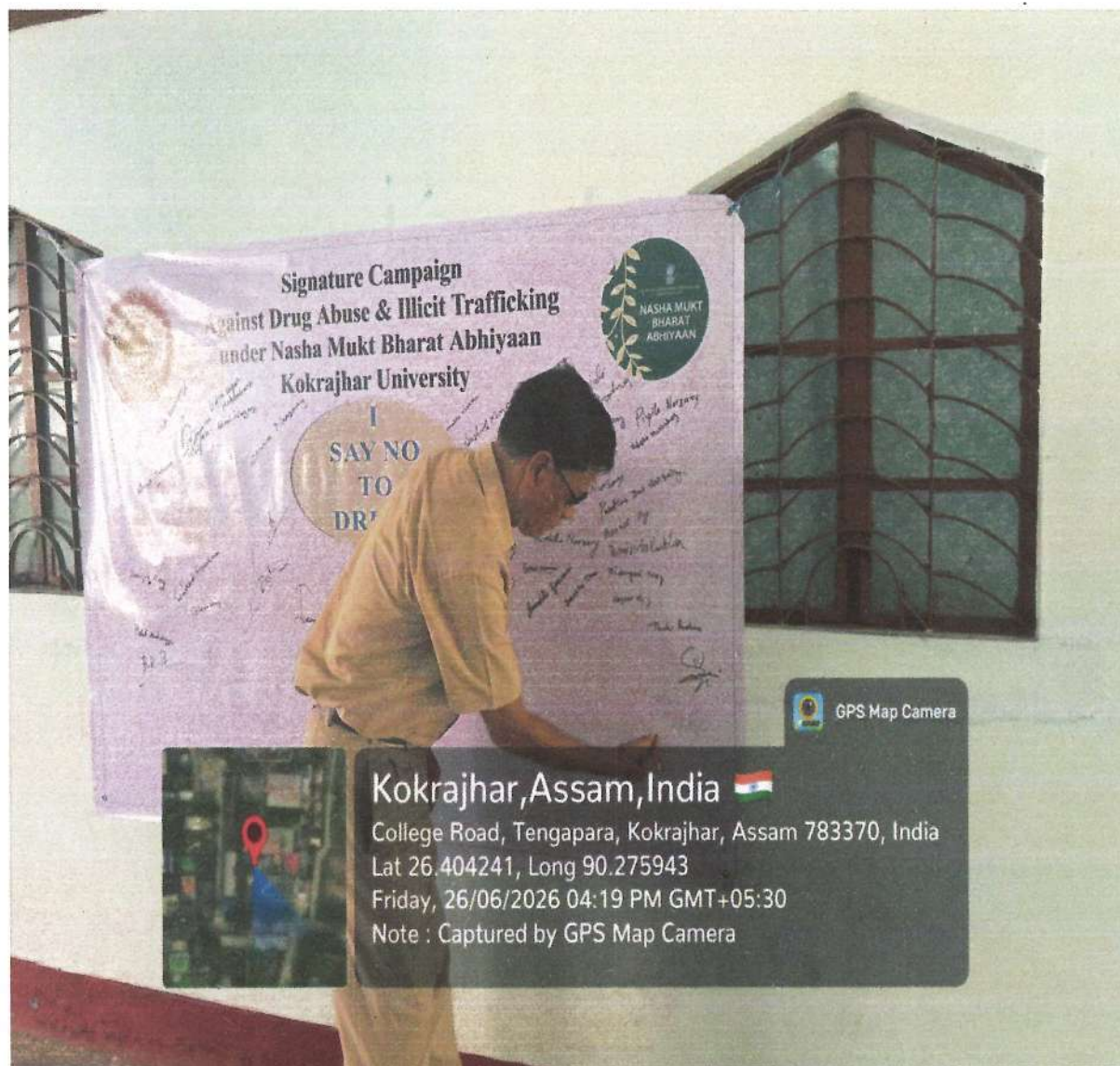



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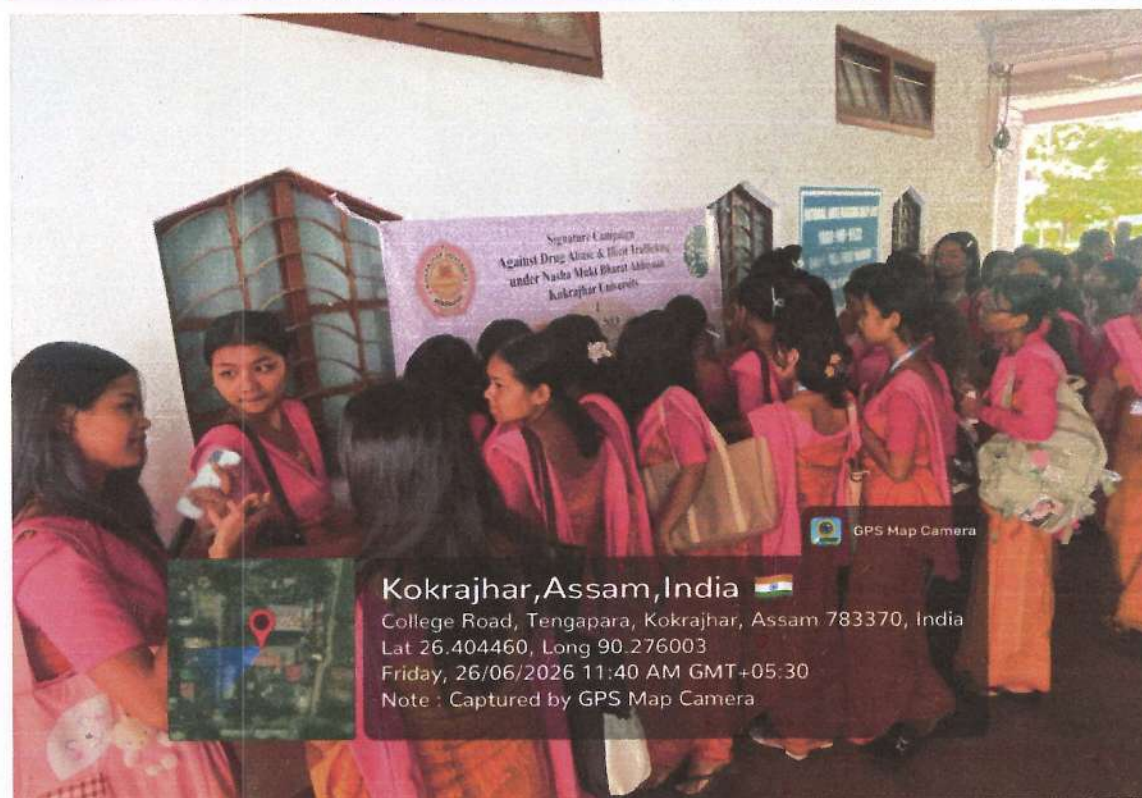
Program 7: Dated: 26th June 2026
